RESOLUTION NO. 144-83
AS AMENDED
ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 16 FOR THE YEAR 1983

By Mr. Hammill, Chairman, Legislative and Judicial Committee

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on July 11, 1983, regarding Local Law No. 16 for the year 1983, and

WHEREAS, prior notification of such local law was provided to the members of the St. Lawrence County Legislature,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Local Law No. 16 for the year 1983 is hereby adopted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a mandatory referendum be held on November 8, 1983, and becomes effective with the legislators taking office on January 1, 1986.

Mr. Hammill made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 144-83, seconded by Mr. Abrams.

Mr. Miller made a motion that the resolution be amended as follows: "And Be It Further Resolved that a mandatory referendum be held on November 8, 1983, and becomes effective with the legislators that take office January 1, 1986." The Local Law was amended as follows: Adding in Section 1 after years, "commencing January 1, 1986." This was seconded by Mr. Hammill.

By a voice vote the amendment carried with twenty-one legislators voting yes and one (1) legislator voting no (Fay).

Mr. Hammill moved the Question to Close Debate, seconded by Mr. Morrill, and carried with twenty-one yes votes and one (1) no vote (Fay).

By a roll call vote on Resolution No. 144-83, as amended, and Local Law No. 16 for the year 1983, as amended, was carried with fifteen (15) yes votes and seven (7) no votes as shown below:

**LOCAL LAW NO. 16 FOR THE YEAR 1983
AS AMENDED
A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING A FOUR-YEAR TERM FOR THE
ST. LAWRENCE COUNTY LEGISLATORS**

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. The term of office for St. Lawrence County Legislators shall be four (4) years, commencing January 1, 1986.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
