

Section 3. The foregoing provisions notwithstanding, all employees in the Sheriff's Department who are presently employed in positions to be classified under Section 1 of this Local Law, who have been continuously employed in said Department for a period of six (6) months or longer prior to the effective date of this Local Law, shall be covered in their respective positions without examination.

Section 4. If any section, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the section, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect upon appropriate filing in the Secretary of State's Office of the State of New York.

LOCAL LAW NO. 10 FOR THE YEAR 1978

A LOCAL LAW INCREASING THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE COUNTY SHERIFF

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. The annual salary for the office of the County Sheriff shall be increased to \$18,500.00.

Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect 45 days following its adoption by resolution of the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators.

Section 3. This increase in salary shall be paid in equal installments beginning on the effective date of this Local Law through the remainder of the year 1979.

Section 4. The annual salary for the office of the County Sheriff beginning January 1, 1980 shall be \$19,500.00.

Section 5. The annual salary for the office of County Sheriff beginning January 1, 1981 shall be \$20,500.00.
