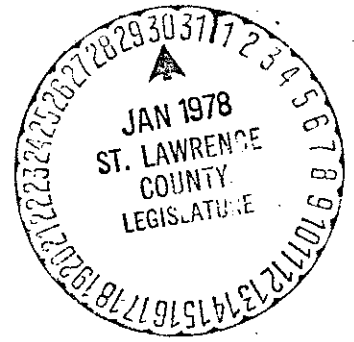

LOCAL LAW NO. 7 FOR  
THE YEAR 1977 - A LOCAL  
LAW AUTHORIZING COLLECTION  
OF DELINQUENT VILLAGE TAXES

Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of Section 1442 of the Real Property Tax Law and of Chapter 319 of the Laws of 1977, St. Lawrence County shall collect delinquent village taxes of villages within St. Lawrence County, for those villages that request such collection by a resolution of their board of trustees.

Section 2. Villages that are requesting collection of delinquent village taxes shall file with the Clerk of the Board of Legislators and the St. Lawrence County Treasurer a certified copy of the resolution of the board of trustees requesting such collection.

Section 3. St. Lawrence County will undertake the collection of delinquent village taxes each year for those villages that have filed resolutions as aforesaid on or before June 1 of the year in question and leave transmitted the account of unpaid taxes and certificate of delinquent village taxes to the County Treasurer on or before October 1 of the year in question.

Section 4. The St. Lawrence County Treasurer shall after receipt of said account and certificate, pay to the Village Treasurer, the amount of returned delinquent village taxes on or before November 30 of the year in question.

Section 5. This law shall take effect immediately upon its being duly filed as provided by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
