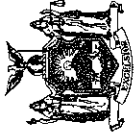



A local law *Fixing the Salary of the Office of Coroner* (Insert title)


