Sec. 1. The 1948 salaries for the following County Officers shall be as stipulated. Salaries included in the Yarger Report shall be determined according to the steps for time service, and P. P. (Flat Rate) salaries determined by the Board of Supervisors.

- A. Commissioner of Taxes..... \$5,512.00 Yarger Report
- B. Commissioner of Elections..... \$6,500.00 P. P.
- C. Personal Officer..... \$9,006.00 Yarger Report
- D. County Attorney..... \$6,500.00 P. P.
- E. County Superintendent of Highways..... \$17,000.00 P. P.

Sec. 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon approval by the electors or upon the expiration of time after a certified copy has been filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
