A local law to provide for weighted voting by members of the Board of Supervisors of the County of St. Lawrence.

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1: On and after January 1, 1968 there shall be thirty-six members of the Board of Supervisors of the County of St. Lawrence. These thirty-six supervisors shall represent thirty-two towns and four wards of the city of Ogdensburg, situated in the county of St. Lawrence. All matters voted upon by said supervisors shall be done by weighted voting and to each voting unit there shall be assigned a number of votes as hereinafter set forth.
