*Requirements to Host Training Courses*

### A. PURPOSE

1. To establish minimum requirements to host training courses provided by the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services (SLC OES)

### B. SCOPE

1. This policy applies to all OFPC and non-OFPC courses offered through auspices of the SLC OES.

### C. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

1. Facilities
  - a) Host department must be able to supply facilities that are commensurate with the course being taught.
  - b) Facilities must be climate controlled to ensure a good learning environment
    - (i) Adequate heat during the winter
    - (ii) Adequate cooling during the summer
  - c) Facilities must be capable of comfortably seating the maximum allowable number of students in the course at tables.
  - d) Facilities should be free from outside distractions (i.e. department activities not scheduled for the same time)
2. Technology
  - a) Courses have varying technology requirements
    - (i) At a minimum a projection screen must be available for video display
    - (ii) Instructors will provide computers and video projectors
3. Equipment



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- a) Host departments are expected to be able to support the course being taught with in-house equipment
  - b) Some specialized courses require specialized equipment (i.e. Rescue Technician – Basic)
    - (i) Equipment lists for these courses are available from the SLC OES
    - (ii) Departments should not request to host these courses if they do not have the equipment needed to run the course
4. Departmental Support
- a) Departments hosting a course are expected to have a representative present the first night to assist the instructor in getting the course started.
    - (i) They are also expected to have a representative available on the remaining nights to support the instructor should problems arise.
5. Course Specific Requirements
