WHEREAS, after a comprehensive planning and competitive RFP process, St. Lawrence County is prepared to request official approval of the Public Safety Complex Renovation Project and award contracts to the successful bidders, and

WHEREAS, following a thorough bid process that included fourteen (14) bidders, the County is pleased with the amount of local interest, which comprised of more than seventy-five (75%) percent from St. Lawrence County, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 74-2023 authorized the Treasurer to modify the 2022 Budget for the Public Safety Complex Capital Renovation Project for the work completed on the architectural and schematic design and preparation of the bid documents, and

WHEREAS, Resolution 101-2023, authorized a portion (\$120K) of the \$5M available ARPA funds for Capital to pay for the schematic design phase, leaving \$4.88M available for use on this project, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 265-2023 authorized the solicitation of bids for renovations and construction at the Public Safety Complex, and

WHEREAS, the County has received bids for general contracting, plumbing, mechanical, and electrical contracting for this project, and

WHEREAS, there will be subsequent approvals necessary for contracts which will provide for the removal of hazardous materials identified in a prior survey, the acquisition of furniture, commissioning services, and security/access or low voltage for the Complex, and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidders for this project have been determined,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Legislators does hereby award the following bids to:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Legislators recognizes that the Director of Emergency Services will maintain a critical role for the duration of the Project and in addition his existing duties, be required to contribute on a daily basis to the new Radio Communications Project and the new 911 Center, and therefore authorizes a \$5,000 stipend, added to the total compensation of the Director, for the duration of the Capital Project not to exceed one year.

Mr. Forsythe thanked everyone involved, and said he is looking forward to the completion of this project.

Mr. Denesha said this is a collaborative effort by many people, and was happy to report that all the firms awarded are St. Lawrence County businesses that employ St. Lawrence County people.

Mr. Reagen said it is important for the public to know that this project is being done without bonding and without paying years of interest, as one-time Federal funds are being used for much of the project. Members of the Board found a way to do a much-needed project that will provide a great deal of benefit to citizens across the county while not burdening them with additional costs.

Resolution No. 409-2023 carried by a roll call vote with fourteen (14) yes votes, and one (1) absent (Terminelli).
