Snowmobile, Ski Trails

The Brasher Falls Trail System is 57 miles in length and is located in the Town of Brasher. It lies primarily on Brasher State forest managed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

The snowmobile trail system may be entered at several different locations. The first location is on the Meyers road off Brasher Center road (county route 53) just north of Brasher Center. Another entrance is at the easterly end of Meyers road at County Route 55. A third entrance is on the McCarthy road.

To the east of the Deer River another snowmobile trail system can be entered via county road 55. Both systems have a series of interconnecting trails, which give the rider a wide selection of loop lengths from which to choose.

The ski trail goes from the Bush Road southerly through the Brasher State Forest to County Road 50.

The system can be reached from County Roads 50, 53 and 55 north of Brasher Falls.
