## Before You Buy: Things to do to Protect Yourself Before Purchasing a Home

- ! Read 100 Q&A About Buying a New Home which is published by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. For a copy, visit www.hud.gov
- ! Consider attending a first time homebuyer course.
- Determine how much you can afford to spend on housing. The amount that you can comfortably spend on housing may be less than what a lender will lend you.
- Evaluate how renting and buying a home compare. !
- ! Compare equivalent listings and recent sales. A real estate agent can be helpful in providing this kind of information.
- ! Compare mortgage terms and lenders.
- Determine if you are eligible for any special financing because of your income and status.
- Find out approximately how much the property taxes will be.
- Find out approximately how much the utility costs will be. Contact the utility company for a monthly average.
- ! Find out approximately how much the homeowners insurance will be.
- ! Find out what all the closing costs will be.
- ! Find out what needs to be replaced and repaired.
- Find out what condition the building is in and what rehabilitation expenses may be necessary. You probably will want to have a professional inspection of the home to make sure that the house is safe and structurally and mechanically sound.
- ! Make sure the seller has clear and marketable title to the property.
- Find out what the water source is.

- ! Find out whether the home uses a sewer or septic system.
- ! Make sure that you like the home and the home's location.
- ! Talk with the owners about the home and why they are selling the home.
