Northern Forest Center Community Recreation Grants

This grant program is intended to help volunteer-led organizations with that new demand. Funding can be used for projects such as trailside interpretive signs, gear lending libraries, safe bike lanes that provide access to recreational areas from a village center, summer outdoor programs, easy-to-read trail maps, or other local priorities (all ideas are welcome). Ideal projects will address some or all of these goals: Reduce physical, financial, and social barriers to participating in outdoor recreation; Use outdoor recreation to address public health concerns; Embrace principles of sustainability, natural resource engagement, and stewardship. Volunteer-led non-profits and municipal groups are eligible for funding.

Kubota Hometown Proud 2023 Grant Program

Kubota will once again invest in FIVE \$100,000 community grants, helping local organizations make an impact in their own communities. To be considered, all grant applications must be entered by a 501(c)(3) nonprofit status organization or a city, town, county, or other municipality. The nominated project must be within a 50-mile radius of an authorized Kubota dealer to qualify. Kubota will judge each entry and select five winners to each receive a \$100,000 grant. Once the five winners are announced, public voting will be live from August 1–14, 2023, when the public will have the chance to select one Kubota Community Choice winner to receive an additional \$100,000 grant.

St. Lawrence River Valley Redevelopment Agency (RVRDA) Community Development and Environmental Improvement Program

The RVRDA is now accepting applications for its 2023 Community Development and Environmental Improvement Program. Eligible applicants include communities and not-for-profit organizations in St. Lawrence County that are planning to undertake a project that will provide a clear and demonstrable economic, community, or environmental benefit. The RVRDA has

allocated up to \$100,000 for this year's program. There is no minimum application amount, but the maximum that may be applied for is \$20,000 though the RVRDA retains the discretion to make exceptions to this maximum if it determines that the circumstances so warrant.

FY 2023 Body-Worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program to Support Law Enforcement Agencies**

BJA seeks applications for funding law enforcement agencies, prosecutors' offices, and correctional agencies performing law enforcement functions to purchase or lease body-worn cameras (BWCs) to establish or expand comprehensive body-worn camera programs with a specific and demonstrated plan to implement this technology to maximize the benefits of BWCs. Funding under this program also supports agencies with existing BWC programs that are seeking to improve the management, sharing, and integration of digital evidence generated from BWCs; optimize how prosecutors leverage BWC footage to improve operations; or use BWC footage to enhance officer training or constitutional policing practices.

USDA Farmers Market Promotion Program (FMPP)

The Farmers Market Promotion Program (FMPP) funds projects that develop, coordinate and expand direct producer-to-consumer markets to help increase access to and availability of locally and regionally produced agricultural products by developing, coordinating, expanding, and providing outreach, training, and technical assistance to domestic farmers markets, roadside stands, community-supported agriculture programs, agritourism activities, online sales or other direct producer-to-consumer (including direct producer-to-retail, direct producer-to-restaurant and direct producer-to-institutional marketing) market opportunities. A 25% match is required.

Deadline: Rolling - grant requests are reviewed on a monthly basis. The Foundation will respond with a decision or request for additional information within 60 days.
