 and Sexual Orientation


## Community Development Block Grants

- Housing Rehabilitation
- 27 awards; \$11 million
- 579 households
- First Time Homebuyer
- 23 awards; \$13.5 million
- 570 households
- Leveraged \$19.8 million
- Affirmatively further fair housing


## Affirmatively Further Fair Housing

- Identify \& remedy:
- Disparities to equal access to housing opportunity
- May be un/intentional
- Examples:
- Different interest rates
- Apartment no longer available
- Higher rent
