
COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

VACCINATION CLINICS:

St. Lawrence County Public Health held its very first vaccination clinic **January 21st 2021**.

Since then... Over **350** clinics were held throughout the county, at over **80** locations, putting in over **1,500** hours. We held our largest clinic at St. Lawrence University, vaccinating over **600** individuals. 152 individuals volunteered their time during 2021-2022 to assist with the COVID-19 vaccine distribution.


