- The RFP will be a new RFP based on a new needs assessment for the County.
- Zachary asked, How often are needs assessments completed? Joanne stated that for the YDP RFP a needs assessment should be completed every 3 years, then you have to report to the state plan on where you have come with your goals based on that RFP.
- Zachary asked that with a 3 year RFP does years 2 and 3 receive less funds because of the budget, like this year had a 5% reduction? Joanne responded with Yes, there is a disclaimer in the contract that states it is based on what OCFS grants, and the grant award can change throughout the 3 years.

- Alexa adds that Ruth would like the Youth Bureau to utilize all means of disseminating
 information about the RFP, she would like to see us double the amount of programs we
 are helping out with YDP funding. Joanne said that's difficult because the funds keep
 decreasing and it's a lot of work for a municipality to put into a grant application and
 receive less funds.

 there used to be a lot more programs funded but the grants also were more. And if
 programs were only getting \$100 they didn't bother following through with the process

 population.






