COURSE OFFERINGS

Certified Phlebotomy Technician

Course Cost \$2,108

The phlebotomist is a vital member of the clinical laboratory team, whose main function is the drawing of blood from patients and taking the blood specimens to the laboratory to prepare for testing. Students completing the Phlebotomy Technician course will attain through lecture, demonstration, and clinical laboratory experience, all the skills necessary to sit for the national certification exam through National Healthcareer Association and for entry-level placement as a phlebotomist. This course is also valuable for current healthcare workers looking to broaden their skills. Pre-requisite: Student must be 18 years of age or older. No prior experience is required, textbook and certification exam included in tuition. Note: The class involves live venipuncture and capillary sticks. Students and volunteers will be asked to sign consent forms.

Certified EKG Technician (Hybrid)

Course Cost \$1.649

This is a comprehensive certification program that prepares students to function as EKG technicians and enables them to sit for the national certification exam through National Healthcareer Association. Technicians work in a variety of clinical settings, including hospitals, clinics, and physicians' offices. They prepare and educate patients prior to collecting diagnostic data used to determine heart function. EKG technicians also work for insurance companies to provide data for health and life insurance policies.

Textbook and certification exam included in tuition. Prerequisite: Student must possess a high school diploma or high school equivalency diploma. No prior experience is required. Note: The class involves live EKG's. Students and volunteers will be asked to sign consent forms.

Certified Clinical Medical Assistant

Course Cost \$3,304

The Certified Clinical Medical Assistant program provides students with the skills necessary to function effectively in the medical "back" office. Training will focus on office procedures, concepts and skills, such as taking vital signs, collecting and processing lab specimens, preparing patients for examinations, assisting with office/ambulatory surgeries and more. Students are eligible to sit for the NHA CCMA Exam at the conclusion of the class.

MIG/TIG Welding

Course Cost: \$787

Pre-requisite: Production Welding or equivalent experience
This course is recommended for individuals who are interested in an introduction to Gas Metal Arc MIG
Welding Operation and Basic Gas Tungsten Arc TIG
Welding. The program focuses on the fundamentals of GMAW bare wire and flux-cored MIG operation and safety as well as machine set up and repair. The course also features 8 hours of GTAW basic set up and operation on mild steel, aluminum, and/or stainless steel. Participants are responsible for providing their own
Personal Protection Equipment (PPE)- a list will be provided upon registration. Apprentice credit available.

Oxyfuel Cutting

Course Cost: \$558

This course explains the safety requirements for oxyfuel cutting. It identifies oxyfuel cutting equipment and provides instructions for setting up, lighting, and using the required equipment. The course covers straight line cutting, piercing, beveling, washing, and gouging. Apprentice credit available. Participants are responsible for providing their own Personal Protection Equipment (PPE)- a list will be provided upon registration.

National Electric Code

Course Cost: \$450

This course provides a navigational road map for using the NEC. It introduces the layout of the NEC and the types of information found within the code book. The class allows trainees to practice finding information using an easy to follow procedure. Apprentice credit available.

Electrical Theory & Alternating Current

Course Cost: \$712

This course offers a general introduction to the electrical concepts used in Ohm's law as applied to DC series circuits. The class covers atomic theory, electromotive force, resistance, and electric power equations. The course also introduces series, parallel, and series parallel circuits. The class covers resistive circuits, Kirchoff's voltage and current laws, and circuit analysis. The course also covers transformers, single phase and three phase power distribution, capacitors, the theory ,and operation of induction motors, and the instruments and techniques used in testing AC circuits and components. Apprentice credit is available for Electrical Maintenance I: Basic Electricity.

Residential Wiring

Course Cost: \$712

When planning any electrical system, there are certain general steps to be followed, regardless of the type of construction. Residential electrical systems are essential for many everyday necessities, including heating and air conditioning, lighting, and household appliances. This module discusses basic load calculations and NEC® requirements for residential electrical systems. It also describes how to lay out branch circuits, install wiring, size outlet boxes, and install wiring devices. Apprentice credit is available for Foundations of Electricity.

Soldering and Brazing

Course Cost: \$390

This course explains soldering and brazing as the two methods used for joining copper tubing and fittings. It describes the safety equipment, tools, and materials needed for soldering and brazing copper tubing in various applications. It also explains the preparations required and the processes involved in soldering and brazing copper tubing. With some practice students will quickly master soldering and brazing techniques. Heavy Equipment Operator

Course Cost: \$7,900

This course will cover the following topics: Orientation to the Trade, Heavy Equipment Safety, Identification of Heavy Equipment, Basic Operational Techniques, Utility Tractors, Introduction to Earthmoving, Grades, Excavation Math, Site Work, Interpreting Civil Drawings, Soils, 30+hour Backhoe competency and 35+hour Excavator competency. Student will receive NCCER recognized certification.




